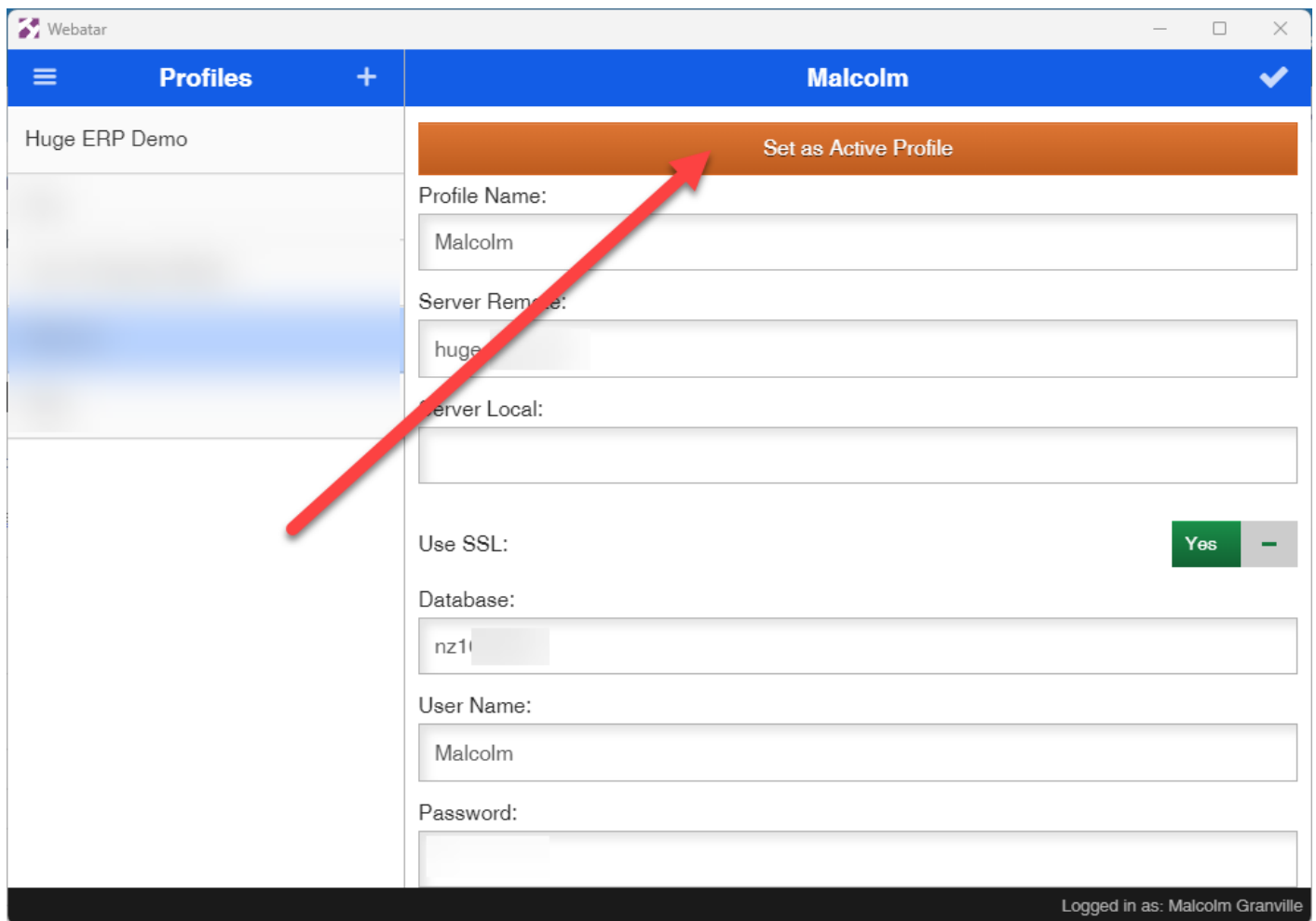

User Name	Your user name to access the system This is case sensitive
Password	Your password to access the system This is case sensitive

Set Active profile

Once all the basic information has been inputted, click on the tick to save all changes.

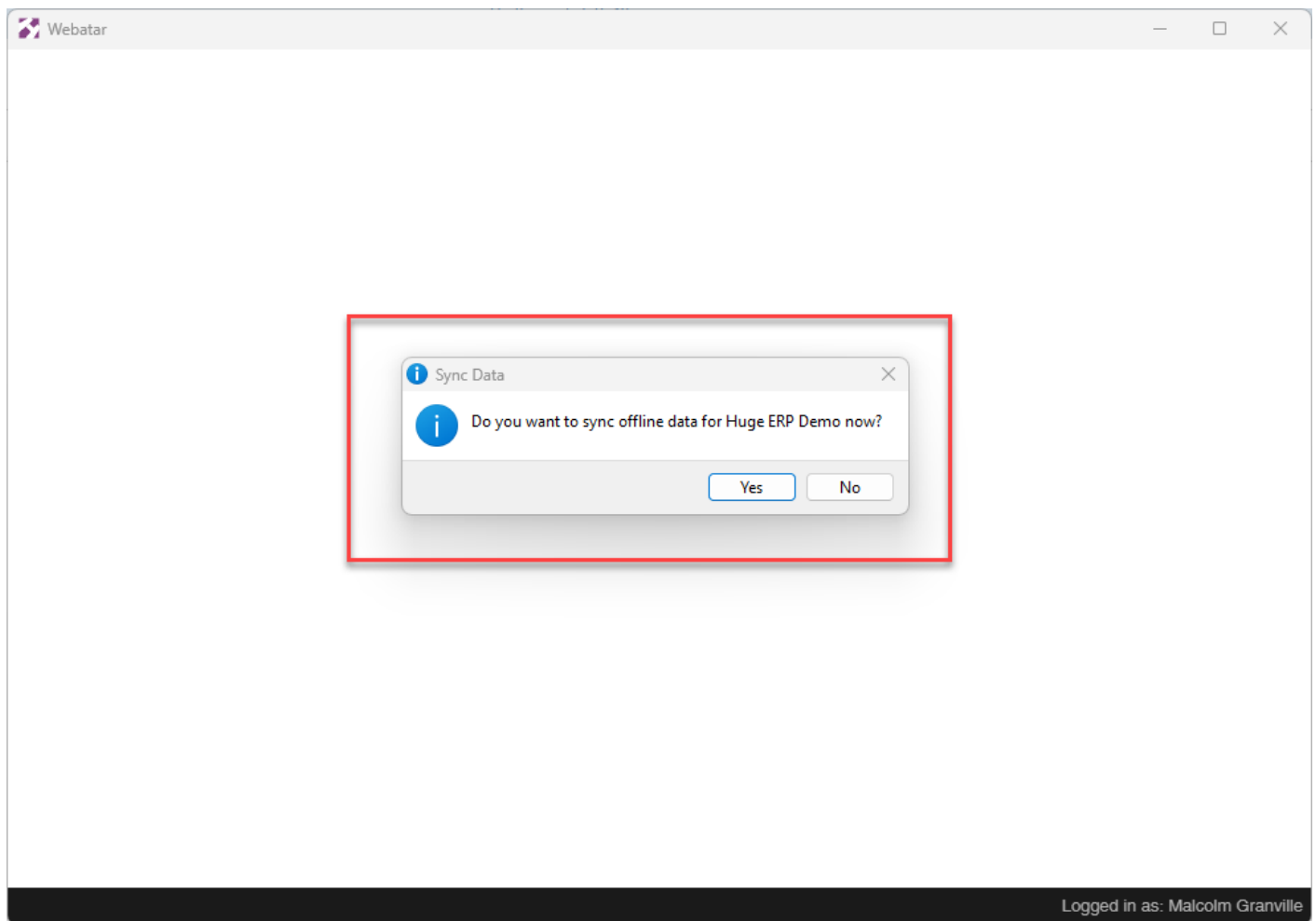
